

The Holy Spirit Fulness It is Supernatural

Introduction:

1. Kathryn Kuhlman *"Please"* she would almost beg saying, *"please don't grieve the Holy Spirit. He's all that I have."*
2. I am going to approach this topic as a person who experientially knows the Spirit of God and so together we will biblically be on a journey
3. Most believers would say "I want the power of the Holy Spirit"
4. I know why I am so hungry for more of the Spirit of God
5. I am grieved because most people either ignore Him or treat Him like an it
6. How many times a day do we not ignore Him?

Communion:

1. I think many people don't understand the word Communion
2. **2 Corinthians 13:14** *"May the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you"*
3. Communion is the word Koinonia – it has three major definitions"
 - a. Fellowship
 - b. Partnership
 - c. Intimacy
4. If you look at the Book of Acts, you will see that the apostles have great fellowship with the Holy Spirit
5. **Acts 20** – Paul speaks of the Holy Spirit speaking to him in city after city
6. My question is – do you have a dialogue with the Holy Spirit?
7. Our answer should be yes because the bible says *"pray without ceasing"*
8. But it is not in the multiplicity of words
9. **Ps 46:10** *"be still and know I am God"*
10. This verse is not so much about meditation, but it is about the mediation of God's kingdom in the heart of faith.
11. The command to be still comes from the Hebrew verb which translated means *to let yourself become weak – in other words let yourself go – surrender*

The Book of Acts Church:

1. Reading the Book of Acts, I realized that what was normal for them is not normal today
2. He partnered with them in everything - ***"It seemed good to us and the Holy Spirit."*** (**Acts 15:28**)
3. They did not say *"The Holy Spirit said and do we"*
4. Example of my wife – she knows what I am going to say before I even say it
5. I know husbands and wives who are strangers after 30 years
6. Some people say *"I wish I could have been there with Jesus"*
7. But look at Paul – Peter writes: ***"This guy Paul knows Jesus so well, some of his letters are hard for me to understand."*** **2 Peter 3:16**
8. The Holy Spirit revealed hidden truths to him
9. Our spirit has the capacity of housing so much more of the Presence and knowledge of God – but we intellectualize the scriptures
10. Our greatest adventures in life can be when we are interacting with Him, but it's a level that's deeper than just the soul.

The Fear of God:

1. **Isaiah 11:2** it *“And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord. And His delight shall be in the fear of the Lord.”*
2. **Ps 19:2** *“the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever”*
3. The fear of the Lord is a hidden word
4. **Exodus 20:20** *“Do not fear because God is coming to touch you to see if there is fear in you”*
5. He's differentiating between being scared of God and fear of the Lord
6. A person who fears God has nothing to hide
7. When we fear God we venerate Him
8. The dictionary defines this as to mean we honor, respect, we reverence Him more than anything or anyone else.
9. it means that we take on His heart and we love what He loves, and we hate what He hates.

Holiness:

1. What is your definition of holiness because the bible says, *“without holiness you will not see God” (Hebrews 12:14)*
2. **2 Corinthians 7:1** *“Perfecting holiness in the fear of the Lord,”*
3. So, the fear of the Lord is the prerequisite to holiness
4. What is your biggest fear?
5. Whatever you fear losing is what is replacing God in your lives
6. The fear of the Lord is to hate evil
7. When you embrace the fear of the Lord, you get a greater measure of the Holy Spirit

Anointing:

1. Why is there not a stronger anointing – a stronger presence of the Holy Spirit?
2. **Hebrews 1:8** – *‘But of the Son he says, “Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom. You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness beyond your companions. And, You, Lord, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the work of your hands”’*
3. Learn to hate sin the way I hate sin and you'll see the anointing of God in your life in greatness.”
4. Me spending time with the Lord – I start with *“Our Father which are in Heaven hallowed be thy name.”*
5. It is one thing to pray – it's another thing to be heard
6. The fear of the Lord will cause your prayers to be heard
7. **Acts 1:8** *“you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you ...”*

Finally:

1. The Holy Spirit makes His home in us
2. **He who the Son has set free is free indeed”**
